It may be spring, but the snow is still way down on the shoulders of Black Butte, discouraging me from any planting in the yard. But spring cleaning efforts at the post are now in progress. Plus, we have several new and promising ideas in the planning and development stages that we should be announcing soon.

The hall has been getting a much-needed fresh coat of paint and is near completion. A special thank you to our maintenance technician, Don Scoggins, for the extra hours he has put into this painting effort. We also need to thank Home Depot for their donation of paint and a paint sprayer to get the job done.

The House Committee has started a new safety inspection program. Post Safety Officer and Jr. Vice Commander Marty Baltazar, who is also a member of the House Committee, has started a monthly program where he will "walk" the post with Don Scoggins checking for safety concerns, such has emergency lights operation and maintenance, fire extinguisher inspections and tagging, AED readiness, emergency exit blockage and identification and other safety concerns. Marty is in the process of preparing an Inspection Plan and a Safety Standard Operation Procedure. It is our hope to see this program as an ongoing, permanent effort to keep our Post safe for all our members and guests.

Thanks to the generosity of our members, we have accumulated a large collection of medical assistance devices; such as wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, canes, shower chairs and other items. What we have noticed is that we get more donations in than we pass out to veterans who need them. St. Vincent De Paul has an established program of reaching out to our community and finding people in need, so we are going to take our excess items over to them. Having this equipment sit in our closets and storage areas helps no one. This is not to say we will be donating all our devices, just those in excess of what we should have on hand to support those veterans that turn to us for help. Please continue to bring us your unwanted, no longer needed medical assistance devices and we will maintain a supply at our Post and donate any excess to St Vincent De Paul.

Hall rentals and events are increasing this year with events scheduled every month. We are also getting plenty of interest from the public in using our facilities. We will have two car shows this summer: a "Wheels for Cancer Car and Motorcycle Show" on Saturday, June 30, 2018 and the "Patriot Pin Ups Car and Motorcycle Show" on Saturday, September 1, 2018. As you may know, last year's Patriot Pin Ups car show generated close to \$5,000 for the Post. These events are money earners for us, as are the hall rentals. With the efforts to put in a new ceiling and fresh paint in the hall, we are making our facility more appealing to potential renters.

We will be asking for some work parties to help with the spring cleanup in these coming months. Please come out and give us a hand when we have a work party. It tends to be the same volunteers every time and we would love to see more of our members out there with us. I'm tired of hearing the same old stories from our regular volunteers.
