





BEND HEROES FOUNDATION

Last month we published an article from Dick Tobiason, Chairman of the Bend Heroes Foundation, on the signing of a bill designating Highway 97 a "POW-MIA" Memorial Highway. This month Dick has provided us with a list of 7 veterans who were POW-MIA whose remains have now been recovered and returned to their families.

PFC Dale W. Ross - US Army, Company E, 35th Infantry Regiment, 25th Infantry Division.

Lost 1/14/92 in the Soloman Islands. Recovery of remains announced April 17, 2019.

Seaman 2nd Class David B. Edmonston - US Navy, USS Okalahoma.

Lost December 7, 1941 in Pearl Harbor. Recovery of remains announced September 20, 2018.

Electrician's Mate 3rd Class Merle A. Smith - US Navy, USS Oklahoma.

Lost December 7, 1941 in Pearl Harbor. Recovery of remains announced September 20, 2018.

Gunners Mate 3rd Class Marvin B. Adkins - US Navy, USS Oklahoma.

Lost December 7, 1941 in Pearl Harbor. Recovery of remains announced April 11, 2018.

Corporal Norvin D. Brockett - US Army, 7th Infantry Division.

Lost December 6, 1950 in North Korea. Recovery of remains announced August 6, 2019. (Will be buried at Arlington Nat'l Cemetery in 2020.)

PFC Lyle E. Charpilloz - USMC, Second Marine Division.

Lost November 20, 1943 in Tarawa. Recovery of remains announced November 29, 2017.

Mr. Edward J. Weissenback, Civilian with Air America Incorporated.

Lost December 27, 1971 in Laos. Recovery of remains announced December 20, 2018.
